

- 2. Mass Add may be used for teachers who teach more than one section each day. Select sections and terms and then it will configure one gradebook shell for each section.
- 3. Copy allows you to select and/or include:
 a)Year (past or present)
 b) teacher
 c) gradebook
 - d) table(s) : Final Marks, Options, Categories, Assignments
- 4. Linking gradebooks is used in schools with Master Schedules for teachers who teach multiple periods of the same subject.

NOTE: Gradebooks must be linked when the gradebooks are created AND <u>before</u> Categories and Assignments are added. Gradebooks should not be linked after Assignments have been added.

Templates

- Security permission (GBK) for teacher(s) to create a template
- 2) The teacher with GBK Template permission will see this option when adding a gradebook
- 3) The view other teachers have when templates are available
- 4) If the template is required, go to the portal option/grade book and check the box. Lock options are also available

• This tab has a variety of set up options. Some are for personal preference and others are required to perform assignment score functions
