Understanding Standards

- Standards are line items listed on a Standards Based Report Card
- State Standards or Local Standards can be used
- Teachers assess and grade the standards listed on a report card
- Districts can apply the following options to standards:
 - Standard Type (level)
 - Mark Types (two options)
 - Applicable Terms for Mark Types
 - Include in Transcript
 - Applicable Grading Terms
 - Corresponding Languages

 - Districts can build a report card from Local standards and not use State Standards
 - If using State Standards, subjects other than English and Math ightarrow
 - Social Science, PE, Science
 - Music, Art, Physical Education
 - Social and Behavioral Standards

- **Count on Missing Mark Report** •
 - Ensures grade submitted by teacher during grading window
- Status displays if standard is active vs inactive status
 - identified
- Not Linkable to Gradebook Assignments ensures teachers • cannot associate the standard to an assignment, for example, **Subject Areas**
