Let's review...



Completion Data - CALPADS expectations


- Every withdrawing Senior student must have a completion status code of E230. This identifies a "completion" status to CALPADS
- The next data entry is "how" the student completed. Listed are the expected completion codes
- Be sure to validate any completion codes that were used that would identify the student as a "drop-out." These codes should always be followed up on and notations made in Aeries to be able to affirm counts when data is shown on public releases.

Student Exit Category Code	Student Exit Category Name	
E230	CompleterExit	Student left school after completing their academic program at this school, whether or not the completion resulted in high school graduation. This includes students who reach the maximum age for high school but do not have enough credits to graduate.
School Completion Status Code	School Completion Status Name	
100	Graduated, standard HS diploma	
120	Special Education certificate of completion	
250	Adult Ed High School Diploma	
320	Received a High School Equivalency Certificate (and no standard HS diploma)	
330	Passed CHSPE (and no standard HS diploma)	
360	Completed grade 12 without completing graduation requirements, not grad	
480	Promoted (matriculated)	

Completion Data - Aeries Management


- The **Grad Status (STU.HSG)** field is primarily used for 12th grade or transfer students. It indicates the completion status for any student who meets High School graduation requirements. Any value in the **STU.HSG field** automatically populates the status of E230 as well as a leave date in the SENR file that is created at the end of an Academic Year.
- Changes to be made once the school year has completed. Early Graduates should be managed as you
 would any student withdrawing within the school year exit reason will be E230 and completer status
 code



Mass Update Graduation Status

- Designed to update students' graduation status at the end of the year for CALPADS reporting
- Can be a tool prior to that to track student progress on multiple requirements
- Will track on 4 areas
 - Graduation Requirements
 - Will verify Algebra 1
 - Can includes credits enrolled
 - Can include inactive students
 - Community Service
 - Can verify community service hours from ACT
 - Competency Tests
 - User Defined Requirement
 - Process
 - Set up the form
 - Load the students
 - Preview the summary
 - Preview the students
 - Reports



Mass Update Graduation Status - part 2

- End of Year reporting to CALPADS
- Can be run at District or School Level
- Will honor Skip or Keep to update for selected students
- Verify that selected options are appropriate
- Options saved at the District Level will be saved for all schools selected
- When running at the school level, process will only run for the school where user is logged in
- Make certain graduation date is populated
- If Community Service hours are required, select the appropriate ACT codes and make certain hours needed is populated
- If competency tests are required, verify definitions
- If User Defined Requirement is needed, select the appropriate options
 - Example: Career Pathways completer requirement CPW.CM = 1
- Save the Setup
- Load Students
- Review Summary
- Select the appropriate graduation code for each group of students
- Review the Students and make needed individual changes
- Print Verification Report
- Update STU and ENR


- Student Met all UC CSU Requirements Indicator
- Student Golden State Seal Merit Diploma Indicator
- Student Seal of Biliteracy Indicator

College Entrance Requirements Page – quick view of progress toward meeting UC/CSU Entrance Requirements

College Entrance Tests Page – view of all College Entrance tests;




College Entrance Requirements

- CRS verify that the Course table is appropriately coded for UC/CSU entrance requirements
- Verify that College Testing has been updated
- View College Entrance Requirements Table for individual students
 - Course Completion Chart
 - Preliminary gpa's
 - Course Completion Status
 - Entrance Status
 - Completer Override students who complete requirements by a means other than high school coursework – example: AP test
- o Run UC/CSU Eligibility Reports format of each matches institution's on-line application

Golden State Seal Merit Diploma

The **Golden State Seal Merit Diploma** screen will allow you to identify the 12th grade students that qualify for this award. It is available while logged in at the School level.


At the end of the school year the form can be used to add Activities and Awards (ACT) records for the students that qualified. Students must have STU.HSG code of 100 and completion date populated in Student Data 2.

The **ACT** records are used in the CALPADS collection of Golden State Seal Merit Diploma recipients.

Process

- Review each subject area tab for appropriate courses, marks, and testing
- 2. Identify other subject areas that could qualify
- 3. Make selections for Miscellaneous Options and Loading Process
- 4. Process and review the students who qualify
- 5. Update ACT

State Seal of Biliteracy

The **State Seal of Biliteracy** page will allow you to identify the 12th grade students that may qualify for this award. It is available while logged in at the School level.


At the end of the school year the form can be used to add Activities and Awards (**ACT**) records for the students that qualified.

The **ACT** records are used in the CALPADS collection of State Seal of Biliteracy recipients.

Process

- Review each course/test tab to identify appropriate courses, departments, and tests that meet the requirements
- 2. Process and review the students who qualify
- 3. Update ACT
