

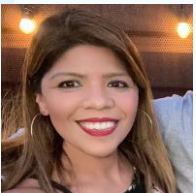

Important Information

To be eligible for the GSSMD, students (1) must be eligible to receive a high school diploma; and (2) must have demonstrated the mastery of the curriculum in at least six subject areas

Program allows partial automation of student identification for the award
Must be run at the site level


LEAs are responsible for the proper setup, calculation and verification based on the requirements detailed in the Requirements Tab

Extract to CALPADS will be based on information populated in the ACT table and Student Data 2

The **ACT** records are used in the CALPADS collection of Golden State Seal Merit Diploma recipients.

Process

2. Review each subject area tab for appropriate courses, marks, and testing
3. Identify other subject areas that could qualify
4. Make selections for Miscellaneous Options and Loading Process
5. Process and review the students who qualify
6. Update ACT

Requirements



Due to the complexity of the Golden State Seal Merit Diploma requirements, all results should be manually verified for accuracy. LEAs are responsible for the proper setup, calculation and verification based on the criteria described in the Requirements tab.

Repeat Courses

Review repeated courses to verify accuracy of completion status

The rule is student qualifies by completing a single course each semester

Verify that the student has completed the curricula for a year's worth of work
