Introduction to CCI

College/Career Indicator

What is CCI?

The California Dashboard College/Career measure shows how well local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools are preparing students for likely success after graduation.

Graduates are identified as **Prepared** or **Approaching Prepared** based on their success on a variety of *coursework* or *assessment measures*.

For schools and LEAs to demonstrate success on this state measure, high school graduates must meet at least one of the criteria in the **Prepared** level.

College/Career Readiness



College/Career Readiness

The College/Career measure shows how well local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools are preparing students for likely success after graduation. Only graduates can be classified as Prepared or Approaching Prepared. For schools and LEAs to demonstrate success on this state measure, high school graduates must meet at least one of the criteria in the Prepared level.

College/Career Readiness Indicators

College or career readiness means completing rigorous coursework, passing challenging exams, or receiving a state seal. The following measures are approved as indicating college or career readiness:

- Career Technical Education Pathway Completion
- Grade 11 Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments in ELA and Mathematics
- Advanced Placement Exams
- International Baccalaureate Exams
- College Credit Course (formerly called Dual Enrollment)
- Completion of a–g Course Requirements
- State Seal of Biliteracy
- Military Science / Leadership

A Warning about CCI Data

The CCI Summary page is *informational* only. Data does not extract from the CCI Summary for CALPADS reporting purposes.

Final CCI status (student and school-wide) is determined by CDE based on data reported to CALPADS from various AERIES extracts, as well as data provided from the College Board and TOMS.

- **Proper Security Permissions in place based on Users and their Roles**

- **Enable the Academic Plan/CCI District Setting for school sites that utilize the Aeries Academic Plan**

Roles

School Site/District Administrators

- **Be familiar with CCI Measures and criteria**
- **Be familiar with where/how CCI-related data is managed in Aeries**
- **Utilize the College/Graduation Readiness Dashboard and CCI Analytics tools to monitor school-wide progress towards CCI preparedness**
- **Support Counselor/Guidance Staff/Teacher efforts towards comprehensive academic planning with students**

Roles

Counselors/Career Guidance Staff

- **Be familiar with CCI Measures and criteria**
- **Verify they have access to the CCI Student Summary page**
- **Know the importance of Course Sequencing**
- **Use the CCI Student Summary as one component to a comprehensive guidance program that guides students towards goal driven planning**

Roles

Parents/Students

- **Understand Student's Goals and Get Involved**
- **Create Portal Accounts and log in often**
- **Create and maintain an Academic Plan that aligns with long-term goals; reference the Academic Plan when selecting courses**
- **Communicate with Teachers and Counselors**

Terminology and Methodology

Overall Status

- Each student (9th grade and above) is given an Overall Status
- The Status given depends on when the page is viewed/calculated



Status	Description	When Status Displayed
Prepared	Completed Graduation Requirements and completion of any one measure	Whenever conditions are met
In Progress To Be Prepared	School still in session; student Graduation Status and at least one of the measures are <i>In Progress</i>	Before the end of senior year
In Progress To Approaching Prepared	Student is neither <i>Prepared</i> or <i>In Progress To Be Prepared</i> . Graduation status and at least one of the second-level measures are <i>In Progress</i>	Before the end of senior year
Needs Attention	Remaining Cases	Before the end of senior year
Approaching	Completed Graduation Requirements And the requirements of at least one of Approaching Measures	After the last day of the school for seniors
Not Prepared	Student is neither prepared nor approaching	After the last day of the school for seniors

Determining Course Completion

A school NOT using Academic Plan

Did the student accumulate as many credits as a typical student would accumulate up until the current term, including the current courses - AND do they have enough time to complete the remaining credits?

CCI Indicator Summary

Six ways to measure being Prepared:

Measure A

Career Technical Education (CTE): Pathway Completion with a C- or better in the Capstone Course

Plus one of the following criteria.

- **SBAC:** At least a Level 3 “Standard Met” on ELA or Mathematics and at least a Level 2 “Standard Nearly Met” in the other subject area
- **College Credit Courses:** One semester/two quarters with grade of C- or better (Academic/CTE subjects).

Measure B

SBAC: At least a Level 3 “Standard Met” on both ELA and Mathematics on Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments.

Measure C

College Credit Courses: Completion of two semesters/three quarters with a grade of C- or better (Academic and/or CTE subjects).

Measure D

AP/IB: A score of 3 on two Advanced Placement (AP) Exams or a score of 4 on two International Baccalaureate (IB) Exams.

Measure E

A to G: Completion of courses that meet the University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU) A–G criteria with a grade of C- or better,

Plus one of the following criteria.

- **SBAC :** At least a Level 3 “Standard Met” on ELA or Mathematics and at least a Level 2 “Standard Nearly Met” in the other subject area
- **College Credit Courses :** One semester/two quarters of with passing grade (Academic/CTE subjects)
- **CTE :** Pathway completion with a C- or better on the capstone course
- **AP/IB:** A score of 3 on one AP Exam OR a score of 4 on one IB Exam

Measure F

State Seal of Biliteracy awarded

AND

SBAC: At least a Level 3 “Standard Met” on ELA

Measure G

Leadership/Military Science: Two years.

AND

SBAC: At least a Level 3 “Standard Met” on ELA or Mathematics and at least a Level 2 “Standard Nearly Met” in the other subject area


Tracking CCI Status – Aeries Analytics

The future of the CCI and CCI related features in Aeries.

- CALPADS – Work-Based Learning extract (WBLR)
 - Being implemented in SY 20-12
 - Currently in development by Aeries
 - Collected as part of EOY 1 submission
 - Allows alternate ways for students to demonstrate Career Readiness
 - Will be added to College/Career Readiness Indicators
- Analytics – Adding CCI Dashboard Measures F & G
