

Dynamic Student Groups

- Dynamic Analytics Group (based on AA data)
- Dynamic Group (based on STU field)

The group dynamically updates the list of students to match data in Aeries Analytics or the selected Student criteria.

NOTE: If more than one AA item is selected, the logic is -OR- (not AND); If you create a dynamic group of students with low Language and Math scores the group will include:

- Students with only low Language scores
- Students with only low Math scores
- Students with both Language and Math scores

With Aeries Communications, selecting the Communications View option automatically creates the Group in Aeries Communication.

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Extended Field Query using Aeries Analytics (AA)

- Extended Fields box appears when Query includes STU table
- Extended fields are available for AA Items
 - Free LCAP Dashboards
 - District-created Dashboards
- This feature seamlessly integrates data from AA into Query results with no complex syntax.
- Extended Student Fields behave like fields in the Student Data (STU) table which makes them easy to incorporate into new or existing queries.

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Extended Student Fields Configuration

- Configuration page displays all AA Items (LCAP and NON-LCAP dashboard items).
- Configuration page available to admins and users with Update permission to Item Definitions.
- Use the page to define the Extended Field names that will be used in Query.
- **Query Column Title** is the name that will appear and be used in Query.; define Extended Field names.
- NOTE: if an Extended Fields title is changed, previously saved queries will no longer work.

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Extended Student Fields Query Command Uses:

- List all students' special education status
LIST STU ID NM SPECIALED
- Get an overall count of students in special education and students not in special education
TOTAL STU SPECIALED BY SPECIALED
- Skip all students in special education
SKIP STU IF SPECIALED = "YES"
- Keep only students in special education
KEEP STU IF SPECIALED = "YES"



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Extended Student Fields Query Command Uses:

- Extended Fields can be used as the value to change TO.
CHANGE STU U9 TO SBAC_ELA.LEVEL
- NOTE: Extended Field values cannot be changed, however. The following is not allowed:
CHANGE STU SBAC_ELA.LEVEL TO 5
- The Extended fields can be used to filter and sort records like any other field.
LIST STU ID NM GR SBAC_ELA IF SBAC_ELA < 4
LIST STU ID NM GR ENGLISH_GRD BY ENGLISH_GRD IF ENGLISH_GRD # " "

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Qualifying Value and Level

Each **Extended Field** actually has two properties: the qualifying value and the level. These properties have different meanings depending on the type of Analytics item on which the Extended Field is based. Examples of qualifying values and levels can be found on **Student Indicator Details** page for a student.

By default, the qualifying value is returned when an Extended Field is used in a query. To use the level instead, append .LEVEL to the end of the name; e.g., SBAC_ELA.LEVEL



- A Case Study – ELPAC and ELPI Scores
 - Issue: ELPAC Levels 1 – 4 ... Ranges are too wide to differentiate progress
 - ELPI Levels created to show progress toward English Language Proficiency

English Learner Progress Indicator

The English Learner Progress Indicator (ELPI) shows the percentage of current English learners making progress towards English language proficiency or maintaining the highest performance level on the end-of-year English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC).

Using ELPAC Results to Measure Progress

English learners take the ELPAC to measure progress towards English language proficiency. Each student receives one of four ELPAC performance levels. The four ELPAC performance levels are then divided into six ELPI levels to allow students enough time to demonstrate progress toward English language proficiency in the ELPI.

AERIESCON

- Aeries Analytics – ELPAC Levels 1-4

- Rather than eliminating ELPAC Levels, ALSO create new ELPI Levels
- Create Item Definition, Label Layout, and Student SubGroup
- The maximum # of levels in AA is 5, so to track improvement, we used:
 - ELPI Level 1 (Same as ELPAC Level 1)
 - ELPI Level 2L
 - ELPI Level 2H
 - ELPI Level 3L
 - ELPI Level 3H
